Project Scope:

Supply labor and material to remodel Women's and Men's public restrooms on floors 5 through 8.

Demolition:

Demolish existing ceramic floor tile, ceramic wall tile, ceramic base, toilet partitions, counters, sinks, and wall coverings. All demolition that creates excessive noise or dust will be conducted after normal business hours. Trash and debris will be removed after normal business hours. Contractor will seal all return air grills prior to start demolition and will remain sealed throughout the construction process. Light fixtures will be dust sealed with clear plastic prior to demolition and will remain sealed throughout the construction process.

Reused Materials:

Reuse toilets, urinals, stainless steel corner guards, stainless steel wall mounted accessories, ceiling grid, ceiling lights, and HVAC supply grills and returns.

New Construction:

Install new ceramic floor tile, ceramic wall tile, ceramic base, toilet partitions, counters, counter mounted soap dispensers, drop-in trash chutes, sinks, faucets, and wall coverings.

Contractor Instructions:

- 1. Contractors will use freight elevators only.
- 2. All contractors and subcontractors are required to sign-in at the Security desk located at the receiving dock upon arrival and leaving site.
- 3. Contractor will provide ID badges to all employees and subcontractors identifying their company that are working on the site. Contractor's employees and subcontractors will be required to be badged at all times while on site.
- 4. Contractors are responsible for protecting adjacent areas to construction site including flooring, walls, and finishes. Protection includes covering floors used to access the construction site.
- 5. Contractor is responsible for damage to adjacent areas as of a result of the construction project.
- 6. Contractor shall maintain a broom clean construction site.
- 7. Contractor will provide a final clean prior to final acceptance by owner.
- 8. Contractor will coordinate utility access with Maintenance.
- 9. Contractor will bid based on provided bid specifications and material quantities.
- 10. Contractor will field verify and confirm quantities prior to ordering and installation.



Women's Restroom Toilet Sink Layout





Women's Restroom Toilet Partition Layout



The Surety understands and agrees that the provision in the Contract that Owner shall retain

certain amounts due the Contractor until the expiration of thirty days from the acceptance of the Work is intended for the Owner's benefit, and Owner shall have the right to pay or withhold such retained amounts or any other amount owing under the Contract without changing or affecting the liability of the Surety hereon in any degree.

It is further expressly agreed by Surety that Owner or its representatives are at liberty at any time, without notice to the Surety, to make any change in the Contract Documents and in the Work to be done thereunder, as provided in the Contract, and in the terms and conditions thereof, or to make any change in, addition to, or deduction from the work to be done thereunder; and that such changes, if made, shall not in any way vitiate the obligation in this bond and undertaking or release the Surety therefrom.

This bond and all obligations created hereunder shall be performable in Harris County, Texas. This bond is given in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 2253 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, which is incorporated herein by this reference. However, all of the express provisions hereof shall be applicable whether or not within the scope of said statute.
