Summer Work-Study Conditions

To be considered for summer Work-Study, students must meet ALL of the following conditions.

- Enrolled at least half time during spring semester 2026
- Approved to receive Work-Study funds for the 2025-2026 aid year by the Financial Aid Office and have completed the HCCS hiring process
- Completed a valid 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Completed a valid 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), submitted all required paperwork, and qualify for Work-Study
- Enrolled at least half-time for summer 2025 or fall 2025, or attest to the intention of enrolling at least half-time at HCC status for fall 2026.

IMPORTANT: Students who are graduating or have graduated from an associate's degree at HCC are not eligible for summer Work-Study. If a student is graduating from a certificate program, they must be pursuing an associate's degree to be eligible for summer Work-Study.
